ePart 2009 is the first edition of a series of annual international conferences dedicated to the research and practice of electronic participation. ePart aims to review research advances in both social and technological scientific domains, seeking to demonstrate new concepts, methods and styles of eParticipation. It covers completed research, ongoing research, practitioner projects, general-interest papers and two special interest workshops. ePart 2009 provides a platform for experts from a wide range of academic disciplines to exchange research results and network in the relaxed atmosphere of the conference set in the 2009 European capital of culture. This year, the many authors represent three continents and sixteen countries.

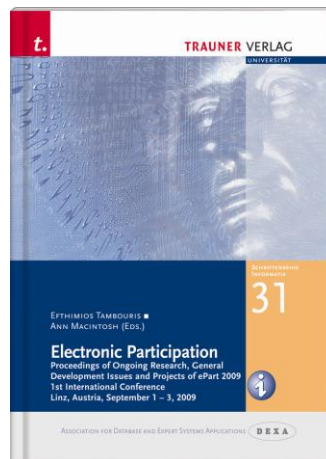
This book on the conference proceedings presents twenty-two contributions of ongoing research, general development issues and projects. The papers are clustered under three headings related to ongoing work in:
